

## 2025-2026 Erasmus Doctoral Mobilities

Doctoral candidates and recent graduates ('post-docs')\* can perform short-term or long-term physical education or internship mobility abroad in order to better respond to the learning and training needs of doctoral candidates and to create equal opportunities. It is possible to add virtual mobility to physical mobility.

\*"Post-docs" can participate in internship mobility within 12 months following their graduation under the same conditions as other new graduates.

### Study

**Application dates:** 16 December 2024 - 3 January 2025 (16:00)

**Mobility period (optional):** summer, 25-26 Fall, 25-26 Spring

\*(Candidates' short-term or long-term mobility preferences will be asked separately after the application.)

\*\*Only fall or spring should be selected in the application portal. The applications of those who choose Fall + Spring (one academic year) will be evaluated as the fall semester only.

For short-term mobility, an acceptance letter from the partner university is required.

**Acceptance letter submission deadline:** June 2, 2025

### Traineeship

The internship activity also includes research activities of doctoral candidates.

**Application dates:** 16 December 2024 - 3 January 2025 (16:00)

**The deadline for submission of acceptance letters:** 17 March 2025

**Mobility period:** June 2025 - June 2026

Mobilities are expected to start in June at the earliest, but visa processes should be taken into account.

**Mobility period:** Minimum 2 months, maximum 12 months

Application requirements and processes for long/short-term study/internship doctoral mobility are as stated in the application calls:

\*A Bilateral agreement at the Phd level is mandatory to be a host university. Long/short-term doctoral study mobility can only be carried out at the partner universities of the enrolled academic program at the doctoral level.

**The distinctive conditions and processes from the application calls are as follows:**

In doctoral mobility, short-term physical activity is a minimum of 5 days and a maximum of 30 days. For long-term doctoral mobility, the minimum period is 2 months and the maximum duration is 12 months. Long-term doctoral mobility may also include a complementary internship programme. Long-term doctoral mobility can be realized as blended (physical + virtual) mobility. In the blended mobility, physical activity must be within the minimum-maximum duration.

Short-term doctoral mobility grants:

<b>Duration of the Mobility</b>	<b>The Grant Amount (Country Associated with the Program or Country Not Associated with the Program)</b>
Up to the 14th day of activity	79 Euro
15th to the 30th day of activity	79 Euro

*\*Individual support grants can be provided for one travel day before the activity and one travel day after the activity.*

Additional Grant Support

Additional grant support may be provided for disadvantaged doctoral students (see calls for applications).

<b>Mobility Type</b>	<b>Additional Grant Support</b>
Study mobility between 2 and 12 months	250 € per month
Short-term student mobility between 5-14 days*	100 € in addition to the daily grant total
Short-term student mobility between 15-30 days*	150 € in addition to the daily grant total

\* In this case, no additional support is given for the internship.

## Travel Support

To contribute to students' travel expenses, the travel grant is calculated based on the distance in kilometers between the starting point of mobility and the activity location. This distance is determined using the distance calculator provided by the European Commission and calculated using the table below:

Grant payments are made in two installments. The first payment is 80% of the total Erasmus+ grant. Payment of the second installment depends on the students' completion of all required procedures and their academic standing (successfully completing/passing at least half of the course credits).
