IMPORTANT! This application form is **only** for Language Proficiency Exams. In order to participate in exchange programs, students must also apply to the relevant Exchange Program by the specified deadlines.

The form must be completed by logging in with your **@std.yeditepe.edu.tr** email account.

Students who wish to apply for **Erasmus+ or other International Exchange Programs** for the **2026–2027 academic year** are required to take the relevant language proficiency exam. (Students who already hold one of the exam results listed below under “**Other Accepted Language Exam Results**” are not required to take this exam.)

- Students must take the exam in the **language of the mobility activity**.
- For **study mobility**, please check the **language requirements** of the partner universities in the agreement list and on the partner university’s official website. It is also recommended to consult your **academic coordinator** regarding course/language compatibility.
- The language requirements stated in the agreement list are for **informational purposes only** and are **not binding**. Partner universities may offer courses in different languages, quantities, or contents each academic year. The fact that courses are listed in a specific language does **not** guarantee that they will be available in that language or that they will fit every student’s study program.
- Students who choose a partner university and take the exam are considered to have **acknowledged and accepted these conditions**. Responsibility for course/language compatibility lies **solely with the student**.

In the [agreement list](#):

- If **only one language** is required, students should take the exam in that language only.
- If **two languages** are indicated with an “**or**”, it means that proficiency in either one is sufficient; however, taking **both exams** is recommended (the **higher score** will be considered).
- If **two languages** are indicated with an “**and**”, students must take **both exams** and achieve the **minimum required score** in each (the **higher score** will be considered).
- In exceptional cases, it has been observed that some partner universities may offer courses in languages **other than** the ones stated in the agreement text.
- The minimum passing score is **60 out of 100**.
- Exam results are **valid for up to 2 years**.

Exam Place and Time Notification

A reminder email including the exam location and time will be sent to students' @std.yeditepe.edu.tr email addresses and will also be announced on the web page. Students attending the exam are required to **bring their student ID cards** with them.

Other Accepted Language Exam Results

- **Language exams conducted in 2024 or 2025** for Erasmus or Global Exchange applications are accepted.
(English preparatory school proficiency exams are **not** valid.)
- **YDS / e-YDS / YÖKDİL**
 - Minimum passing score: **66 / 100**
- **TOEFL IBT and PBT Exams**
 - Accepted **only** from test centers of **Yeditepe University, Istanbul Technical University (İTÜ), and Middle East Technical University (METU)**.
 - Minimum passing score for **TOEFL IBT: 79** (*TOEFL IBT Home Edition is not accepted*).
 - Minimum passing score for **TOEFL PBT: 550**
- For **languages not examined at Yeditepe University** (e.g., Italian, etc.): Certificates issued by **Cultural Centers affiliated with the relevant Consulates** will be accepted, provided that they indicate a **B2 level** and specify the student's **score on a 100-point scale**.

Students must **upload their valid exam results** to the **Application Portal** during the application process.
