# WHO CAN APPLY?

**TEACHING MOBILITY:** Academic staff required to give lectures at the University.

TRAINING MOBILITY: Academic- Administrative staff legally employed by the University.

\*\*Academic and administrative staff must be legally employed by "Yeditepe University".

#### ADDITIONAL SUPPORT FOR DISABLED STAFF

Additional financial support can be provided to disabled academic/administrative staff (Accompanying person's accomposation, travel expencess.. etc.) through a separate application to the National Agency.

#### 30.03.2024 - 30.10.2024

- Mobility Activities must be carried out by 30 October 2023.
- Due to application evaluation / approval, visa processes and travel preparations, it is recommended not to set a date before 30 March 2024 for mobilities.

#### **APPLICATION DOCUMENTS**

Applications will be made through an E-DEVLET entry via <a href="https://erasmusbasvuru.ua.gov.tr/">https://erasmusbasvuru.ua.gov.tr/</a>. The requested documents will be uploaded to the portal.

Important Note: After logging into the portal; You will see two calls for applications separate for (1) USA, GAMBIA, GEORGIA combines and separate for (2) RUSSIA only. It is important to check the name of the call you are applying for.

1. Study Plan: Draft Training/Teaching Agreement, which will include the activities to be carried out on a daily basis (After this document is signed by the applicant, it does not need to be signed by the institution to be visited at the application stage, but must be signed by the supervisor at the employed University (approved in assignment and annual leaves). If the application is accepted, the content of the form to be approved is expected to be largely the same. In this context, it is recommended to exchange views with the counterparty on content.)

# **TYPES OF MOBILITY – DURATION**

It is obligatory that the activity lasts at least 5 consecutive activity days.

- **1. TEACHING MOBILITY**: In order for the activity to be valid, it is mandatory to give at least 8 lesson hours during 5 working days / 1 week.
- 2. TRAINING MOBILITY: It is the field of mobility that allows academic or administrative staff to receive training. Within the scope of this activity, it is possible for the person to receive various trainings (such as on-the-job trainings, observation processes) in order to improve the skills they have in their current job. Conference participation cannot be supported within the scope of the mobility.





**3.** "COMBINED" TEACHING & TRAINING MOBILITY: In cases where teaching and training activities are carried out together, the minimum teaching period is one week or 4 hours for short-term activities.

# **GRANT**

- It is foreseen to grant 5 days for the duration of the mobility and 2 days for the travel days (7 days in total).
- In case the mobility and travel days are on the same day, a one-day grant payment can be made.
- Staff can also participate in the mobility without receiving a grant or with partial grant.\_BUT an application is still a must to be selected within the Erasmus programme.
- The activity periods of the staff should be fully granted, or the activity can be carried out completely without a grant, that is, with a "zero grant". There is no option to partially grant the activity period.
